
## Introduction

All businesses and governments need to generate documents.

Document automation is a common digitization requirement for most medium- to large-sized organizations. This doesn't come as a surprise; according to a <u>Zapier study</u>, 76 percent of workers spend 1-3 hours a day simply moving data from one place to another. Additionally, 73 percent spend 1-3 hours trying to find specific information or a particular document.

By switching from manual to automatic generation of documents, organizations can save resources, prevent errors, and increase productivity.

There are several options to choose from when generating documents on Power Platform. This paper will examine these options to help determine the best choice for different use cases.



## What tools to use for document generation in Power Platform?

In this document, we will cover four ways for generating documents on Power Platform. Two of them use Microsoft tools only; the other two use third-party solutions.

All of them rely on Power Automate for setting up the workflows for populating the document templates with data and automating the sending / saving process.

## **Using Microsoft tools only**

Using only Microsoft tools for generating documents offers the benefit of dealing with a single supplier. This potentially eliminates cross-compatibility issues and incompatible updates. However, these tools were not specifically tailored for document generation on Power Platform, leading to complexities in setup and usage.

## Microsoft tools only

## Microsoft Word + Power Automate

The first and simplest method for document generation involves using the Developer tab in Microsoft Word to create document templates, combined with the Word Online Connector to integrate with Power Automate.

This approach is suitable for basic document generation needs. It may fall short for producing complex documents in high volumes.

### **Pros**

- · Well-suited for quick, simple tasks
- · Ideal for documents using simple templates
- Affordable for moderate workloads

### Limitations

- · Not ideal for lengthy documents with complex layouts
- Restricted support for conditional logic and formulas
- Limits on the number of related records, levels of relationship, and number of root entities
- Costs can increase with extensive workloads

## Power BI + Power Automate

This method involves Power BI paginated reports. Templates are created in Power BI Report Builder and then populated with data and distributed to their intended destination using Power Automate.

Using Power BI might not be cost-effective if used solely for document generation. This makes this option more appropriate for medium- to large-sized companies with several hundred users.

## **Pros**

- · Suitable for complex documents
- Capable of handling complex gueries
- Overcomes the limitations of Microsoft Word in template creation

### Limitations

- Power BI is primarily designed for report creation, not document generation
- Requires skills in report-building
- May not be cost-effective for smaller companies

## Third-party addons

## What to take in mind when considering a third-party add-on

Using third-party add-ons to generate documents on Power Platform offers several benefits, enhancing the native capabilities of the platform and addressing specific needs. Let's look at the points to consider when choosing a third-party add-on.

## The key advantages of third-party addons

Customization and advanced features: Third-party add-ons often provide tailored user-friendly interfaces and include custom templates, advanced formatting options, and the ability to incorporate complex data structures.

**Scalability:** As businesses grow, their document generation needs become more complex. Third-party add-ons are built to scale, supporting increased document volumes and more sophisticated document generation scenarios.

Rapid Deployment and Updates: Add-ons can be quickly deployed and easily updated, ensuring that businesses can take advantage of the latest features and improvements without significant downtime or development efforts.

**Support and Expertise:** Third-party providers often offer dedicated support and bring specialized expertise in document automation, ensuring that businesses can address any issues swiftly. Opt for a provider with a strong track record of reliability and consistent support.

## What to consider

**Procurement process:** Selecting a third-party solution requires comprehensive market research and a clear understanding of your organizational needs. Choose vendors who offer substantial support during the procurement process.

Data storage and handling: Regulations in many countries mandate domestic data storage. Additionally, certain industries are governed by strict data handling rules. Verify the provider's data storage locations and management practices.

Additional data management: Some add-ons may store configuration records in Dataverse, and they might install workflows, scripts, and business rules. This can result in increased storage costs and fees for API calls. It's important to understand the data structure and operational mechanism of the chosen solution.

**Performance Issues:** In some cases, complex queries — especially in large volumes — might process slowly and even cause timeouts. Discuss performance capabilities and limitations with your provider.

With these considerations in mind, let's explore the available options.

## Third-party addons

## Solutions using Microsoft Word to design templates + Power Automate

Various solutions utilize Microsoft Office products, primarily Microsoft Word, for template creation. These templates are then integrated with Power Automate through dedicated connectors.

Solutions like Documents Core Pack by mscrm-addons and Document Automation Software by Experlogix allow template designing within Microsoft Word. Dox42 extends this to include Microsoft PowerPoint and Excel for template creation.

Document templates and data connections are created in familiar office software. No programming skills are needed. Business users can create the document templates by themselves. The solutions overcome Microsoft Word's limitations by supporting dynamic tables, conditions and calculations, diagrams, deeper relational data handling and business logic integration.

The third-party addons also often support data import from various sources and enable data sorting, filtering, and exporting documents in multiple formats.

## **Pros**

- Ease of use users work in a familiar environment
- Advanced functionalities for complex use cases
- · Addons are specifically designed for document automation

### Limitations

· Potential slowness and timeouts with complex queries

## Third-party addons

## Resco Docs+ with a Document designer + Power Automate

Resco Docs+ is an addon that utilizes its own Document designer, natively integrated in model-driven apps. This means users can complete tasks without opening other software. The add-on employs a proprietary Power Automate connector.

With the Documents designer, users can employ grids to design pixel-perfect documents. Data can be added from numerous sources and from multiple tables (related or unrelated), and they can be sorted and filtered. The solution is also compatible with Resco Forms+ for instant document creation from field data.

Resco Docs+ supports rules, repeatable groups, and complex business logic. All parts of the report are built in a low-code / no-code, point-and-click environment.

The solution performs well, with average document generation requests typically taking less than 12 seconds. Even complex reports with non-trivial rules and calculated columns are processed swiftly.

The outstanding performance stems from the design of the solution. Resco is well-known for its platform that enables developers to create mobile business applications. Field users employ these apps to accomplish their work tasks, including document generation. Workers needing service reports, invoices, or inspection protocols can generate them on-the-go using pre-defined templates in their mobile apps.

This document generation functionality is now also available on Power Platform. Resco has preserved the reliability and speed of its original product in its Power Platform enhancement.

The solution is well-suited for organizations seeking a swift, reliable method to address complex use cases, and those comfortable with a slightly more complex template generation process that remains coding-free.


